**Memorandum of Understanding
between
Architectural Institute of Taiwan (AIT)
and
International Initiative for a Sustainable Built Environment (iiSBE)**

Whereas, Architectural Institute of Taiwan (AIT) is actively promoting the "Low-Carbon and Sustainable Building" with global vision, local characteristics and green building technologies. Architectural Institute of Taiwan (AIT) and International Initiative for a Sustainable Built Environment (iiSBE) are mutually interested in signing a contract on Sustainable Building Research Collaboration. The two bodies expect to promote further development to enhance international exchange of global architecture and building construction researches and industrials. Thereby, both parties sign articles as follows.

ARTICLE I

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to develop and carry out collaborative activities in furtherance of the common interest of the institutions set forth in ARTICLE II.

ARTICLE II

The scope of collaboration on Sustainable Building research and activities included in this Memorandum of Understanding includes the following categories:

1. Architectural Institute of Taiwan (AIT) will actively involve in the world sustainable building conference co-sponsored by the International Initiative for a Sustainable Built Environment.
2. The International Initiative for a Sustainable Built Environment provides Architectural Institute of Taiwan (AIT) with the SBTool assessment researches and recommend outstanding researchers and experts to participate the coming conference in Taipei.
3. Cooperation and exchange of information with a common cognition of the sustainable built environment action, the global building and construction industry, and community issues.
