

ARTICLE III

To implement the aims and purposes expressed in ARTICLE I and II, the following is mutually understood and agreed:

1. Proposals for collaborative work under this Memorandum will be submitted through the nominees of Architectural Institute of Taiwan (AIT) and the International Initiative for a Sustainable Built Environment.
2. Each part will nominate one of its members as its representative in charge of the cooperative program. Individual programs of work under this Memorandum will be jointly planned and conducted by the nominees of both parties.

ARTICLE IV

1. This Memorandum of Understanding is effective as of the date of execution by the appropriate officer of each signatory institution.
2. This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended at any time by mutual consent and shall continue and effect for three years and can be extended by mutual consent of both parties.
